1. **Statutory Protection for Unborn Children** – *Roe-v-Wade, Doe-v-Bolton, and Planned Parenthood-v-Casey together mandate abortion throughout all nine months of pregnancy, with no meaningful exceptions.*

2. Parental Consent

In many states, like California, parents have the legal right to be notified if the school is conducting medical, cognitive, and language screenings of children. All parents have the right to participate in parent councils and committees, and the right to join the school's parent-teacher association or organization (PTO/ PTA).

3. Abortion Counseling.

Lawsuits have been brought against public schools as a result of school personnel counseling or assisting students in obtaining abortions without parental knowledge or consent. The Thermalito School District was assessed damages of \$3.2 million when a student's abortion resulted in serious medical complications.

4. School-Based Clinics

Planned Parenthood and other abortion promoters are seeking to establish school-based "health" clinics whose primary purpose in reality is to offer contraception and abortion counseling/referral services.
